


CITI Training

The guide below will show you, step-by-step, how to register and sign up for courses required by Illinois State University for human subjects research in the CITI program.

1. Go to www.citiprogram.org and Click on the **Register** box in the top right corner of the screen.



2. Type in Illinois State University in the 'Search for Organization' box and then click 'I AGREE to the terms of service....' and the "I affirm" statement and then click 'Continue to create your CITI Program Username/Password'.

Select Your Organization Affiliation

This option is for persons affiliated with a CITI Program subscriber organization.

To find your organization, enter its name in the box below, then pick from the list of choices provided. 🗨️

Illinois State University only allows the use of a CITI Program username/password for access. You will create this username and password in step 2 of registration.

3. Enter your name and **your ISU email** address. You can include a secondary email address, but this is not required. Next, click on 'Continue to Step 3'.

4. Create a username and password. Identify a security question and then click on 'Continue to Step 4'.

Create your Username and Password

* indicates a required field.

Your username should consist of 4 to 50 characters. Your username is not case sensitive; "A12B34CD" is the same as "a12b34cd". Once created, your username will be part of the completion report.

* User Name

Your password should consist of 8 to 50 characters. Your password IS case sensitive; "A12B34CD" is not the same as "a12b34cd".

5. Enter your country of residence, then click 'Continue to Step 5'.

You will also need to indicate what course you plan to take. Select "Basic Human Subjects – Social & Behavioral Focus."

8. Next you will be asked which Curriculum you are interested in taking. For Question 1, **select the second option (Educational, Social, and Behavioral research with human subjects) if you are faculty or staff.** A student conducting research considered “no more than minimal risk” research can complete the shorter “Students conducting no more than minimal risk research” course. Make sure that you select one of the options in Question 1 since they cover BASIC information. Do not sign up for Refresher courses under Question 2. For the remaining questions covering additional course subjects, select “not at this time” or skip them if that is not a choice. At the end, click on the “Complete Registration” button to continue.
